<b>Constant Prepayment Rate</b>	Annualised equivalent rate of Pre-payment amounts from borrowers. Excludes Seller repurchases.
<b>Cumulative Pre-payments</b>	Pre-payment Amounts aggregated since deal inception.
<b>Current Balance</b>	As defined in the Master Definitions and Construction Schedule. For the avoidance of doubt all occurrences of this term include arrears and capitalised fees.
<b>Excess Spread</b>	Revenue waterfall items (g) & (i) - (o), less any amortisation of the General Reserve Fund, applied to Class A Principal Outstanding.
<b>Geographical Distribution</b>	The following codes apply:
	UKC - North East UKD - North West UKE - Yorkshire & Humberside UKF - East Midlands UKG - West Midlands UKH - East Anglia UKI - Greater London UKJ - South East UKK - South West UKL - Wales
<b>Indexed LTV</b>	Current Balance divided by indexed latest full valuation. The indexed latest full valuation uses combined Halifax and Nationwide indices for indexation up to 30 <sup>th</sup> June 2016 and Office for National Statistics indices for indexation from 1 <sup>st</sup> July 2016.
<b>Months in Arrears</b>	Arrears balance divided by contractual monthly payment, rounded down to the nearest integer value.
<b>Origination LTV</b>	Loan balance at inception divided by the valuation used for initial loan assessment.
<b>Pre-payment Amount</b>	Payments of principal occurring prior to the contractual payment date, for reporting months only.
<b>Principal Payment Rate</b>	Annualised equivalent rate of Principal receipts from borrowers, scheduled and unscheduled. Excludes Seller repurchases.
<b>Unindexed LTV</b>	Current Balance divided by the latest full valuation.
